### 1.1 SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This device complies with international safety standards.

- Before commissioning, please read the safety instructions carefully and keep the operating instructions within easy reach.
- Observe the warnings on the device and in the operating instructions.
- Never allow children to use electrical appliances unattended.

**Ambient conditions:** Protect the device from moisture and heat and do not expose it to direct sunlight. Open fire sources, such as burning candles, must not be placed on the device. Avoid placing the receiver in areas with insufficient ventilation. Keep a clearance of at least 10 cm above and at least 5 cm from the side of the device, so that the resulting

heat can be dissipated without hindrance. Do not place objects filled with liquids, eg. As vases, on the device. Avoid the penetration of foreign bodies and liquids into the device. Do not expose the device to dripping or splashing water.

**Power Supply:** Only connect the receiver to the power supply after you have completely wired it. Avoid overloading the power outlet, power supply lines or a power supply. This could lead to fire or electric shock. Disconnect from the mains during prolonged absence: If the unit is left unattended for a longer period of time (eg holidays / holidays), you should disconnect it completely from the mains.





#### 5.1 FIRST INSTALLATION

The **FIRST INSTALLATION** starts with the first connection of your device.

Here you select your **menu language**. To do this, use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to the different languages and confirm this with the **OK** button (the default is 2 DEUTSCH).



After confirming the menu language, the receiver loads the program list preinstalled by the manufacturer.

# **6.1 INSTALLATION** (ANTENNA SETTINGS / PROGRAM SEARCH)

To configure your receiver to the correct antenna setting and start a program search, press the button **MENU** on your remote control and navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to the Menu **Installation**.

Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK**. Now navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to the menu item **Antenna Settings**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the button **OK**.

You can now scroll up and down with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  through the following menu:

# 6.2 INSTALLATION (ANTENNA SETTING / SCR / dCSS)

In a **SCR / dCSS one-cable-soloution-system**, you must assign your receiver a corresponding **Userband frequency** (Center Frequency) and the **IF program number** (IF Channel).

For this, you should know these values before installation. Ask the installer of your antenna system if you do not know these parameters.

To program these parameters, proceed as follows:

Press the button **Menu** on your remote control and navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown$  to **Installation**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Navigate now with the buttons  $\blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown$  to **Antenna Settings**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.

Use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to go to **LNB Type** and confirm by pressing the OK button. A new selection menu opens.



Use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to select your **LNB Typ** and confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. You have the following options:

IF Channel.



Scan Mode Navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to Scan Mode. Use the

**Start Search** Navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to **Start Search**. Use the

Multi-TP Search

Press the **OK** button on your remote control to start the

search.

#### **Important:**

When starting a search, ALL previous programs will be deleted. All newly found programs must be re-sorted.

# 6.3 INSTALLATION (FAST SCAN)

To start a **Fast Scan** - for providers - press the button Menu on your remote control and navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to **Installation**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to **Fast Scan**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.

Here you can set the following parameters (see next page).



**Provider** Navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to **Provider.** Use the

buttons ◀ / ▶ to select your Provider: nC+ HD, Polsat,

UPC Hungary, Magio Sat, Digi SK, Pantelino, etc....

Satellite As soon as you have selected your **Provider**, the

corresponding **Satellite** is automatically entered on which

your chosen **Provider** sends.

**Transponder** As soon as you have selected your **Provider**, the

corresponding **Transponder** is automatically entered on

which your chosen **provider** sends.

**CHS Renumber** Navigate with the buttons  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  to **CHS Renumber**. Use the

buttons ◀ / ▶ to select "On" / "Off".

#### 6.4 INSTALLATION / FACTORY DEFAULT / PIN

To reset your receiver to the factory settings, press the button **MENU** on your remote control and use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to navigate to **Installation**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now navigate with the buttons ▲ / ▼ to **Factory Default**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Use the **number keypad** of your remote control **(0-9)** to enter the PIN (password) (default password is 0000) and confirm it with the button OK. The password can be changed at any time in menu under **Parental Control**.

#### **ATTENTION \***

If you select ALL, all settings, satellites, and programs will be deleted. The receiver restarts and starts with the FIRST INSTALLATION

# 6.5 INSTALLATION (USALS SETUP / MOTOR)

If you use this receiver with an outdoor system, that has a USAL System (Universal Satellite Automatic Location System, you must make the appropriate settings in the **USALS Setup** menu. To do this, press the Menu button on your remote control and use the  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to navigate to menu **Installation**. Confirm the menu item by pressing the **OK** button. Now navigate with the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to the menu **USALS Setup**.

For the USALS to work properly, you must enter the coordinates (**latitude** and **longitude**) of your location so that the system can calculate all the engine positions for the receivable satellites (for more information, please refer to the user manual of your satellite motor).

To navigate, use the buttons

▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ and select
your value. Enter the latitude-/
longitude angle directly using
the numbers on your remote
control.

By pressing the **RED** button you can select presets (**Setup by Country**).



To save your settings and exit the menu press the EXIT button.

### 7.1 MANAGE PROGRAMS

To manage the programs in the various program list categories, press the button **MENU** on your remote control. Use the  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to navigate to the menu item **Edit Channels**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now you have the possibility to manage different program lists:

TV Channels Radio Channels TV Favorites Radio Favorites
Sort Channels
User Channel List

Select the program list category you want to edit by using the  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons and confirm it with the **OK** button on your remote control.



**TV Channels** Here you can edit the Program list of TV Channels

Radio Channels Here you can edit the Program list of Radio Channels

**TV Favorites** Here you can edit the favorites list of TV Channels

Radio Favorites Here you can edit the favorites list of Radio Channels

Sort Channels Here you can sort ALL programs at once according to

the following sorting parameters:

Alphabet, Transponder, FTAtoCAS, Default, Favor,

FTAtoCAS+Alphabet, Provider, Service ID

**User Channel List** Here you can save or reload the preset program list

### 7.2 MANAGE PROGRAMS (MOVE)

To change the program position of a program in your program list, press the **Menu** button on your remote control. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to menu item **Edit Channels**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now select your **program list** with the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons you want to change and confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.


The following example shows you how to change a program position in the program list category "TV programs":

Press the **RED** button on your remote control to select the **move mode**.

- Use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to select program you want to move.
- 2.) Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.
- 3.) The program is marked with "▶▶" in front of the program name.
- 4.) Now move your program with ▲ / ▼ to the new program position
- 5.) Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.
- 6.) The program has now been moved to the new program position.
- 7.) If you want to move further programs, proceed again as described under point 1.

### If you want to move several programs at once:

- 1. ) Use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to navigate to "one" of the programs you want to move.
- 2.) Press the **RED** Button on your remote control (**MOVE**)
- 3.) Now press the **BLUE** button
- 3.) The program is now marked with \$\diangle\$ behind the name of the program.
- 4.) Now use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to navigate to other programs that you also want to move and marker them by pressing the **BLUE** button.



5. ) If you now want to move ALL marked programs to one program position, use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to navigate to the program position where ALL marked programs are to be saved one after the other and press the OK button.

Exit the menu by pressing the **EXIT** button several times.

# 7.3 MANAGE PROGRAMS (DELETE)

To delete programs in your program list, press the **Menu** button on your remote control. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to menu item **Edit Channels**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now select your **program list** with the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons you want to change and confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.

The following example shows you how to change a program position in the program list category "TV programs":

- 1.) Use the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to select program you want to delete.
- 2.) Confirm your selection by pressing the **GREEN** button. The program is now marked with " **X** " in front of the program name.
- 3.) If you want to delete more programs, use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to go to the next program you want to delete and press the **GREEN** button to marker also next program to delete.
- 4.) If you now want to **delete ALL marked programs** at once, press the **EXIT** button on your remote control.
- 5.) You will be asked: "Do you really want to delete?"
- 6.) Use the ▶ button to select from "NO" to "YES" and confirm by pressing the OK button.
- 7.) All programs you have previously selected have now been deleted in the program list.
- 8.) Exit the menu by pressing the **EXIT** button several times.

### 7.4 MANAGE PROGRAMS (LOCK)

To lock programs in your program list, press the **Menu** button on your remote control. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to menu item **Edit Channels**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now select your **program list** with the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons you want to change and confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.

The following example shows you how to change a program position in the program list category "TV programs":

- 1.) Use the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to select program you want to lock.
- 2.) Confirm your selection by pressing the **YELLOW** button. The program is now marked with a "**key lock symbol**" behind the program name.



- 3.) If you want to lock more programs, use the buttons ▲ / ▼ to go to the next program - you want to lock - and press the YELLOW button to marker also next program to lock.
- 4.) If you now want to **lock ALL marked programs** at once, press the **EXIT** button on your remote control.
- 5.) All programs you have previously selected have now been locked in the program list. Exit the menu by pressing the **EXIT** button several times.

#### **Important:**

The programs will not be actively locked until you have activated "Parental Control". Refer to "8.3 SETTINGS (PARENTAL CONTROL/PASSWORD CHANGE)" in this user manual (Page 24).

# 7.5 MANAGE PROGRAMS (RENAME)

To rename program names in your program list, press the **Menu** button on your remote control. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to menu item **Edit Channels**. Confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button. Now select your **program list** with the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons you want to change and confirm your selection by pressing the **OK** button.

The following example shows you how to change a program position in the program list category "TV programs":

- 1.) Use the buttons  $\blacktriangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  to select program you want to rename.
- 2.) Press the BLUE button on your remote control to rename the selected program.



The following buttons are now available to use:

**RED** button Switch between the **standard** or **extended character** set

If you want the receiver to remember the last playback position and start playback of PVR\* recordings always starting from the last playback position, please set this setting to "Last Position".

#### **USB Speed**

Press the **BLUE** button to display the "**USB Speed**" diagram. The diagram on the right shows whether the connected USB memory is expected to be fast enough to save SD programs (yellow) or HD programs (blue) TV and timeshift on HDTV (HD + TMS, green).

## 11.2 PVR FUNCTION (DIRECT RECORD)\*

#### Start a directly Record

To start a **directly record** on your connected USB stick or external hard disk, press the " • " button. Pressing the INFO button displays the recording time in the upper right corner.

#### **Stop Record**

Pressing the button "USB/■ "on your remote control stops recording immediately. Answer the question: "Do you want to stop current record?" by selecting with the buttons ◀ / ▶ "YES" / "NO" and confirm your selection with the OK button.

## 11.3 PVR FUNCTION (RECORD WITH EPG PROGRAMMING)\*

To using the **EPG** (Electronic Program Guide) for record function, press the **EPG** button on your remote control. The Program Guide opens:



Use the buttons  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  /  $\triangleleft$  /  $\triangleright$  to navigate to the program that you want to program for timer programming (here for example: **10: 57-11:58** on program **SAT.1** the Film "**Anwälte im Einsatz**"). Press the **RED** button (Edit Timer) to program this film for recording.

## 11.4 PVR FUNCTION\* (TIMESHIFT)

With the Timeshift function, you have the option of breaking or pausing a running TV program. The TV program is then recorded on your USB storage device (USB stick or external hard drive) and can be continued later. To start a timeshift recording, press the pause button ▶ II for pause while playing a program. To continue watching the stopped program, press the button ▶ II for play. Use the ◀ ◀ / ▶ ▶ buttons to fast forward or rewind playback. The stop button USB/■ aborts the time shift recording.





## 12.3 NETWORK (IP SETTINGS - WiFi)

To assign a **manual IP address**, press the Menu button on your remote control and use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to the **Expansion** menu item. Confirm this menu item by pressing the **OK** button. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\nabla$  buttons to navigate to the **IP setting** menu item and confirm by pressing the **OK** button. You will now be shown the network parameters:



If you navigate to the **DHCP** menu item using the ▲ / ▼ buttons, you can use the ◀ / ▶ buttons to switch between "**On**" (automatic assignment of an IP address) or "**Off**" (manual entry of the network parameters). If you have selected "**OFF**" in the **DHCP** menu item, you can enter the network parameters (Address, MAC Adress, Address mask, Gateway, DNS1, DNS2) manually by using numbery buttons on your remote control. After complete input of the parameters, navigate to the menu item **Confirm** and confirm your selection with the **OK** button.

## 12.4 NETWORK (NETWORK APPs)

To start the network apps, press the Menu button on your remote control and use the  $\triangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to navigate to the Expansion menu item. Confirm this menu item by pressing the **OK** button. Navigate with the  $\triangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to **Network Apps** menu item and confirm it with the **OK** button. The menu with the Network apps opens. Use the  $\triangle$  /  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to select you nezwork app and confirm the app by pressing the **OK** button.


